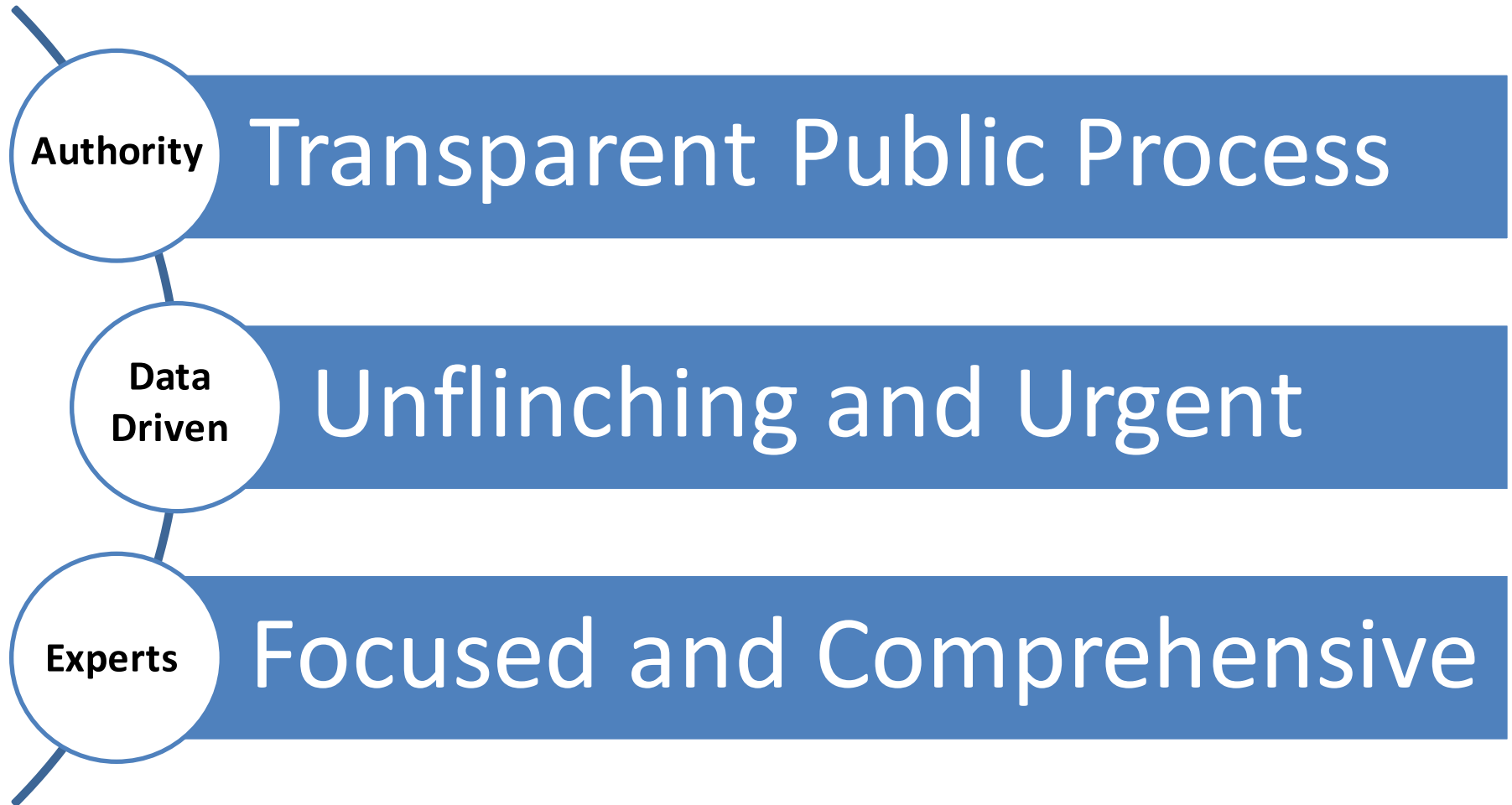

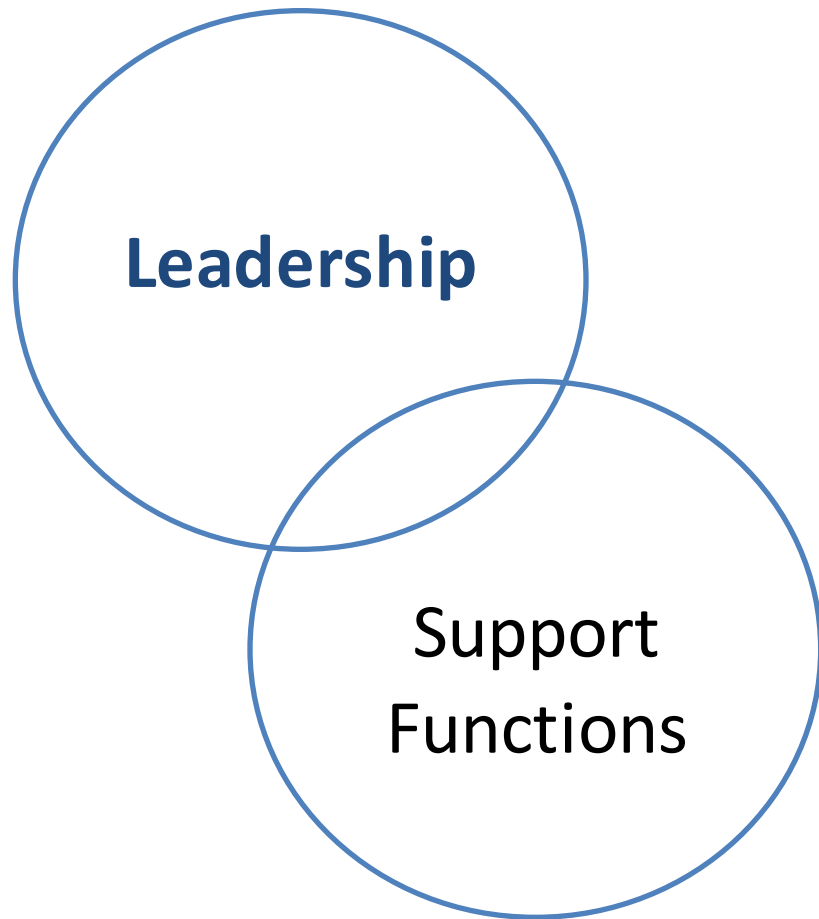

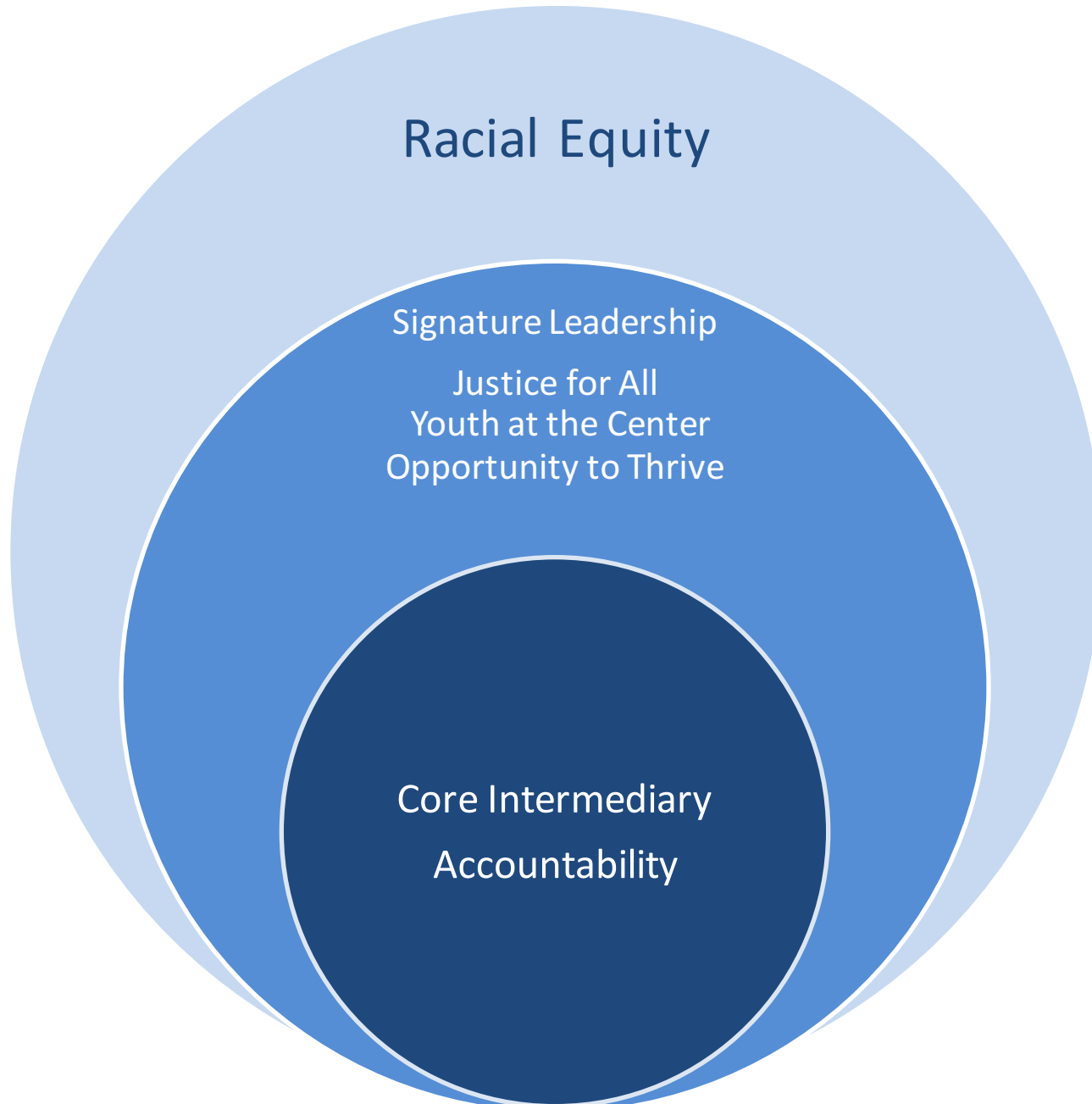
1. Support Functions of Core Intermediary

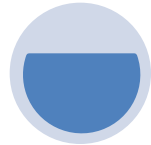

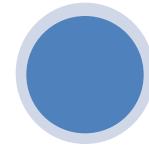

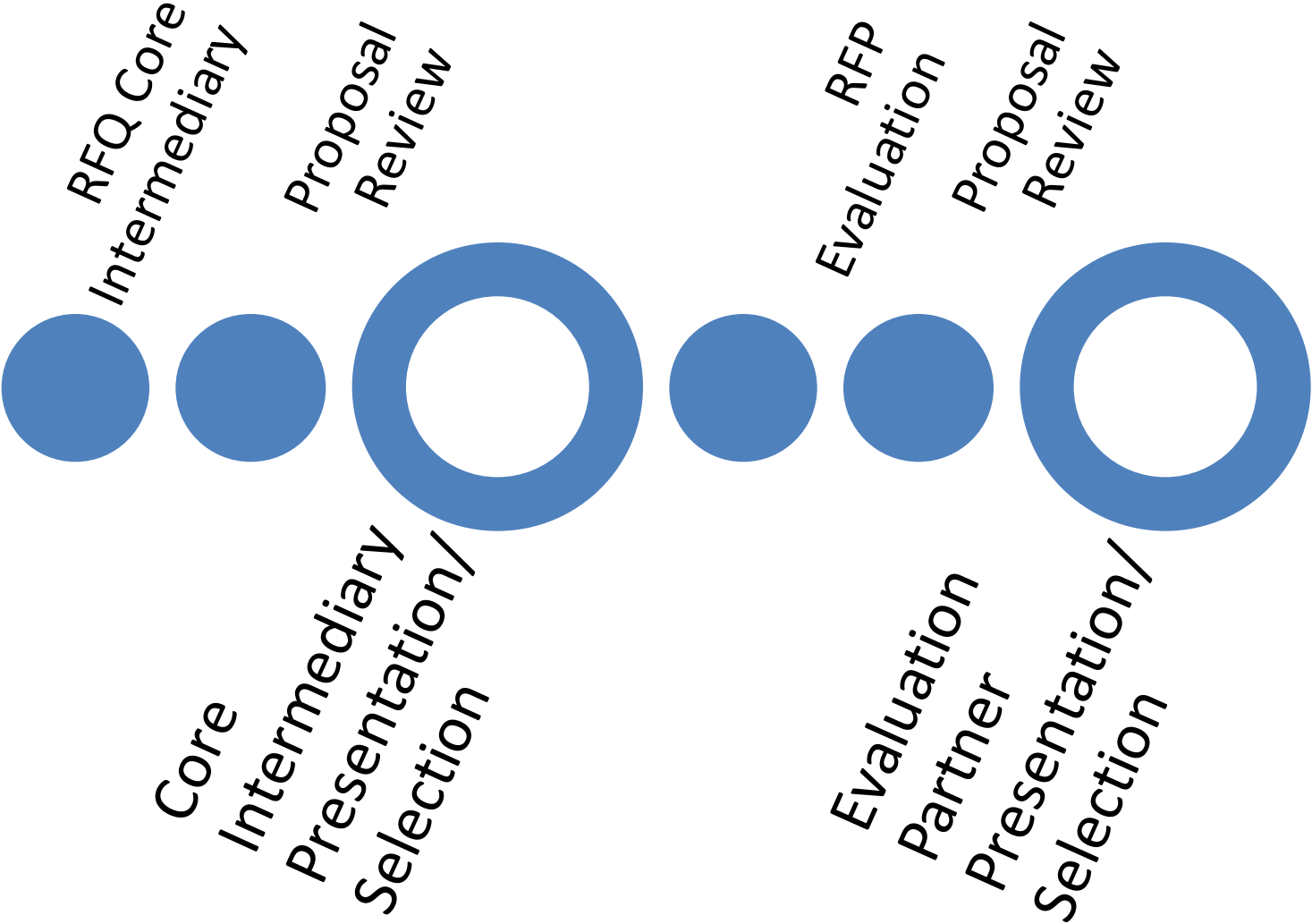


Leadership
